

Lake Fork Firearms, LLC Range Rules

All safety rules are enforced and must be obeyed for the benefit of all. Non-compliance with these rules will result in loss of Range use and forfeiture of fees. If you are unsure about anything, please ask.

- All shooters must register at the front desk before entering the Range.
- No food or drinks allowed in the Range. No smoking. No alcoholic beverages on premises.
- No one is allowed to shoot while under the influence of drugs or alcohol. LFF's call.
- LFF has the right to inspect all firearms and ammunition to be used in the Range.
- No one under 18 permitted without Parent or Legal guardian. You must be 21 to purchase handgun ammo.
- Eye & ear protection is mandatory for all persons entering the range
- No person is allowed beyond the firing line for any reason.
- No center-fire high-power rifles allowed.
- Shoot only in the lane you are assigned.
- Shoot only at your own target. Shooting at anything else (light baffles, target hangers etc.) will result in loss of Range use. No hip or fast draws.
- Pregnant women will fire at their own risk (lead exposure).
- Firearms being carried to and from the firing line must be unloaded and in a gun box or bag.
- Consider every firearm loaded until checked. Never trust your memory or another person's word.
- No dry firing is permitted, except while on the firing line with the muzzle pointed down range.
- Never load a firearm until you are within the shooting booth, with the muzzle pointed down range. Never point a firearm anywhere other than down range.
- In case of a misfire, keep the firearm pointed down Range for at least 30 seconds. After waiting, clear the firearm and check the barrel for obstructions or call for assistance.
- Shooters can pick up only brass they shoot that lands on their area only. No brass can be removed from in front of the firing line.
- A maximum of two individuals will be permitted per one shooting lane. Only one person is permitted to shoot at a time. The non-shooting individual must stay in the same area as the shooter.
- Carelessness or thoughtlessness will not be tolerated. No disorderly conduct, horseplay, or abusive language will be allowed, The strictest discipline must be observed in the Range to prevent accidents or injuries.
- A \$100.00 repair bill will be administered for any bullets that strikes the ceiling resulting in expulsion from the range.
- A \$50.00 repair bill will be administered for any damage done to the walls.
